



ALBANY PRESBYTERY TEMPORARY CHAPLAIN

PURPOSE: To offer pastoral care and strengthen relationships of Albany Presbytery.

While the Staffing Task Force completes its process and any subsequent search, the temporary chaplain will address the connectional and relational concerns of the presbytery.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Coordination and offering of Pastoral Support for all Ministers of Word and Sacrament and Commissioned Elders.
- Provide oversight of AP Pastoral Care Teams.
- Cooperative work with the Koinonia Team and the Committee on Ministry and Congregations.

QUALIFICATIONS/SKILLS REQUIRED:

- **Relational:** Is able to build collaborative relationships.
- **Pastoral:** Is able to come alongside ministers and commissioned elders in times of crisis.
- **Connectional:** Is able to offer resources to ministers and commissioned elders for ongoing care.

HOURS: 10 hours per week.

LOCATION: The duties of the position will be performed remotely.

ACCOUNTABILITY: This non-exempt position is accountable to the Presbytery through its Personnel Committee. This position is governed by the Personnel Policies and Manual of Albany Presbytery.

EVALUATION: A semi-annual evaluation and review of the Temporary Chaplain will be conducted by the Personnel Committee, and the results will be reported to the COMAC, and the Coordination Committee.
