

### **Henry Edward Morren Memorial**

The Rev. Henry Edward Morren, an Honorably Retired minister member of Albany Presbytery, died on Saturday, Nov. 18, 2017, at Mountain View Center in Rutland at the age of 91.

He was born on June 12, 1926, in New Augusta, Mississippi, the son of Henry E. and Lizzie (Mixon) Morren. After graduating in 1944 from high school in New Augusta, he served two years in the U.S. Navy. He then attended Jones County Junior College, graduated in 1950 with a B.A. from the University of Southern Mississippi and in 1953 with a B.D. from Columbia Theological Seminary. He was ordained a Minister of Word and Sacrament in September 1953.

He served as pastor of Presbyterian churches in Mississippi and Arkansas and then worked at River Refining Co. and Chicago Spectro Services Laboratory in Illinois. He was served as pastor of Garfield Boulevard Presbyterian Church in Chicago, the Presbyterian Church in Graniteville and First United Presbyterian Church of Parkesburg, Pennsylvania, retiring in 1989.

During retirement, he served the Poultney Welsh Presbyterian Church, as an area supply pastor, and participated in Fair Haven Concerned and the Fair Haven Clergy group.

Survivors include his wife, Jeanette, of Fair Haven; twin sons Jonathan Morren, of Mount Joy, Pennsylvania, and Justin Morren, of China, Michigan; a stepson, Kerry Claffey, of South Strafford; a sister, Katherine, of Mississippi; several grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

Henry's funeral service was held on Monday, Nov. 27, at the Fair Haven United Methodist Church. Burial followed in Cedar Grove Cemetery in Fair Haven.
