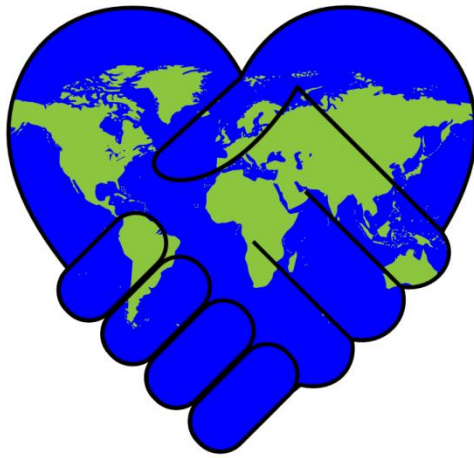


Welcoming the Stranger
