

## 2020 CAMPERSHIP POLICY

Once again, Albany Presbytery will offer financial support to young people connected with our churches, who plan to attend Christian summer camps.

## Elements of the program:

- 1. Applications will be accepted online from Feb. 1 through March 1, inclusive.
- 2. The order of online filing establishes the order of priority among complete applications.
- 3. To be <u>complete</u>, an application must also include a paper co-signed by a parent/guardian <u>and</u> a pastor, moderator or Session clerk. Download that form here and send the completed form to Presbytery's mailing address PO Box 83, Watervliet NY 12189 attn: Camperships. You may also email the completed form to <u>info@albanypresbytery.org</u> with "Camperships" in the subject line.
- 4. Parent/guardian must attest to the level of financial need: Would the child <u>not</u> be able to attend Christian camp without a \$250 grant from Albany Presbytery, sent directly to the camp in the child's name?
- 5. Absent this attestation, the child can still qualify for a \$100 campership, also sent directly to the camp.
- 6. Pastor, Moderator, or Session Clerk must attest that the child belongs to the "extended family" of the local congregation.
- 7. In 2020, we will no longer observe any distinction between camps that are owned by organizations "in correspondence" with the PCUSA and camps owned by other Christian ministries.
- 8. As in previous years, If your child is planning on attending Camp Fowler you will be provided a "coupon number" to be used on your registration.
- 9. All applicants whose application is approved will be notified via email. Once approved a check will be written directly to the camp prior to the camp date. Since most week-long camp experiences are \$425 or more, the initial camp deposit will need to be paid by the family or the church. Checks will only be written to the camp once a child has paid the down payment registration. Any difference left after the registration deposit fee and the campership fund is to be paid by the family or church.
